## Shuttle Details

Sequoia Shuttle's external shuttle service provides affordable, convenient, and comfortable transportation from Visalia to the majestic Sequoia National Park, seven days a week, during Summer. [Book your trip today, reservations are required.](#) The shuttle only stops at pick up locations that have been booked with a reservation.

## To The Park

The shuttle departs Visalia five times a day between 6:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m.

## From The Park

Trips from the Giant Forest Museum return to Visalia five times a day between 2:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m.

## In-Park Shuttle

Sequoia Shuttle also operates four free in-park routes within Sequoia National Park. No tickets are required, and bus stops are clearly marked throughout the Park. See reverse for more information.

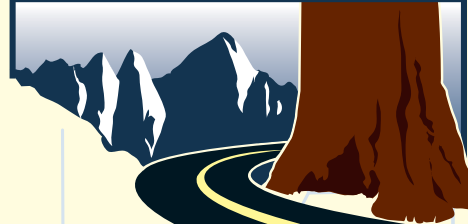

## BE DRIVEN

Enjoying the Sequoias has never been easier! You can now sit back and relax while taking in the beautiful scenic ride through the majestic Sequoias. Enjoy the splendor of Sequoia National Park's natural wonders, like the General Sherman Tree, Moro Rock and Crescent Meadow, all without the hassle of driving or having to find parking.

## GETTING TO THE PARK

The Sequoia Shuttle, operating during Summer, is your first and last stop to the majestic Sequoia National Park. The shuttle departs from various convenient locations throughout Visalia several times a day, seven days a week before traveling through Three Rivers up to the Giant Forest Museum. Each 16-passenger shuttle features comfortable seats, luggage space, and an informative video during the trip. Shuttles are wheelchair accessible.

## ONCE INSIDE THE PARK

Once inside the Park, visitors benefit from unlimited access to four free in-park shuttle routes traveling to several popular destinations. Feel free to hop on and off anytime during the operating hours of 9am & 6:30pm. There are no tickets required for these shuttles and visitors are free to board or depart from any stop. Each route is identified with a colored icon.



## ABOUT THE PARK

Sequoia National Park is one of the oldest National Parks in the United States. Spanning over 400,000 acres, the Park was established in 1890 to protect the big trees in the Giant Forest, including the General Sherman Tree, the world's largest living thing. The Park also features Mt. Whitney, the highest mountain in the contiguous 48 states, reaching 14,494 feet.

Though most Park visitors arrive by private vehicle, the increasing number of motor vehicles in the Nation's Parks threatens the very resources the Parks were intended to protect. Sequoia National Park receives over 1 million visitors every year. More visitors means more traffic on Park roads and parking areas, resulting in lengthy delays and roadway congestion. This congestion translates to air and noise pollution which threatens the fragile natural and cultural resources within the Parks.



Help preserve our national treasure by cutting back on vehicle congestion and pollution. Leave the driving to the Sequoia Shuttle.

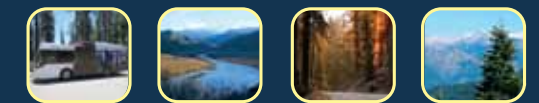
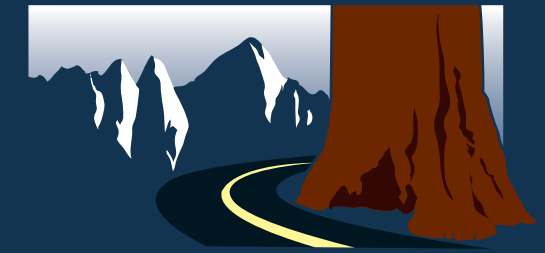
